6. New Business:

- Budget Approval Phil presented the budget. Registrations are up so projection a 4-5% increase for 2018/19.
- We have a casino this season.
- The tournament made \$12, 250.00 This years tournament will be November 9-11, there will be no U19 division as we are short on ice and further cuts maybe necessary.
- We are projecting \$49,000 from fundraising this year.
- Budgeted \$10,000 for provincials to be divided up between teams that qualify to attend.
- Budget set aside to upgrade our website.
- We are predicting a total of \$340,000 in total expensise for this 2018/19 season. We will vote on the budget in August.
- Trevor to check with Competitive Thread regarding evaluations as our current cost is \$6500 for evaluations and this may be more now with higher registration numbers.
