1) Opening Remarks: Everyone in attendance will receive a \$50.00 credit towards registration for the 2017-2018 season as long as registration is complete and paid in full prior to June 30, 2017. You need to sign in at this meeting to receive the credit.

4) Reports by Executives:

President - Jen Rogers – Jen thanked all of our sponsors, namely Stratomer IT, Sherwood Ford, Holiday Inn, United Cycle, Radisson Hotel, Arkann RV, Infinite Eye, Canadian Brewhouse and Align Orthodontics. Jen also thanked all the board members, families, athletes, coaches and team managers for a great year.

Highlights of the year included:

U10-U19 – 19 teams (two more teams than last year)

95 of those players are in U10 with another 60 players in Active Start. Our base is strong and we are growing as we continue to grow a little each year. 11 teams attended Ringette Alberta playdowns. Four teams went on to provincials U14A, U16AA, U19A, and U16B – who brought home gold. Five U10 teams played off in BGL playoffs where we brought home one gold and two silver.

Tournament – Presently we are unsure of the Tournament dates. Can tell you it will not be on a regular weekend. The way the system presently works we need to take / trade ice from SPMHA (approx. 65 game slots) over one weekend. SPMHA plays interlock with EMHA. Every 6 weeks they re-tier their teams. This requires SPMHA to make up 65 games over 5 weeks, which is very difficult. We are working on possibly hosting the tournament over the Christmas break December 28-30. There is definitely a negative with these dates, however, there are

many positives as well: do not need to take time off school or possibly work, right now many associations run tournaments in October and November. There is very few tournaments in the north offered in December or January.

Ice Allocation – We have our ice allocation for next season. Looks much like this season with a couple minor changes. The total hours for the season are almost identical to this season.

We have managed to get a slot at Broadmoor Saturdays 9:30AM for our Active Start 1 program. Active Start 2 will run Saturday mornings at GARC and Mondays at Broadmoor.

One thing the Board took time to create this year was a Mission and Vision Statement. Phil Bloomfield lead a group of board members in creating the statements. After many hours of revisions we finalized the statements in March (the statements were read).

Vice President – Linda Poole – Linda reported that SPRA received four family complaints. An ad hoc committee was convened to investigate and no fault was found.

- Review of 2016/2017 Financials Stacey Heinish last year's financial statements were audited. a) We have four bank accounts. \$61,000 is in the reserve fund. The jersey fund has \$7250 which we replace jerseys every five years or so. We have \$61,000 in deferred revenue. \$7031 in net income. Income from registration fees is \$200,311.32. We paid \$177,622.15 for ice.
- Review of 2017 Year End Forecast registration down from budgeted. Increase to tournament revenue b) then originally forecasted. We paid for attending teams to go to provincials. Difference in revenue is 50/50 Oilers fundraising which was not accounted for. Income of \$22,276.81.
