

Player ‘Special Request’ for consideration for Team Placement

Policy Scope:

Players in the SPRA are able to submit requests to be placed on the same team as friends and family members, however, are limited to one (1) request per player.

Philosophy & Intent:

This policy is intended to ensure that ‘special requests’ are limited, and do not interfere with SPRA’s goal of achieving balanced teams, within the division(s).

Boundaries & Guidelines:

- Each request must be signed by the parent/guardian of the player(s) involved in the request. (ie. Player ‘A’ and Player ‘B’ want to play together. Player ‘A’ submits request, must have Player ‘B’s signature, agreeing to the request.) This represents the Special Request for Player ‘A’ and Player ‘B’. No further request will be considered from either player.
- Requests must be submitted at time of registration and prior to commencement of the grading sessions, on the form provided on our website (www.sherwoodparkringette.ca). No requests will be accepted or considered once grading sessions have commenced.

Application Guidance

SPRA’s receipt of a ‘Special Request’ does not guarantee that this request will be met. Our main goal is to provide equal, balanced teams. Requests may only be accommodated if the balance of teams is not upset.

Timing Requirements
