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Sherwood Park Ringette announces the final step in the launching of their Power AA Program. Based on our membership feedback and support, SPRA is pleased to announce the intent to host a U19 AA squad in the Power AA Program for the 2018-2019 season. The expansion of the program will continue with the 2002 cohort of athletes and offer opportunities for athletes at U14, U16 and U19 to compete at this level.

The AA program was launched in 2015 and has continually grown and developed over the past three seasons. Our U16AA team had its most successful season yet, with two gold and one silver medal in tournament play. They won a silver medal at provincials, earning a berth as Team AB2 at the Canadian Ringette Championships.



“The SPRA has been working with the AA community and advisors, including Ringette Hall of Famers Phyllis Sadoway, Lorrie Horne and Jennifer Rogers, as well as Ringette Alberta and Ringette Canada, to bring this full program to our community and we are excited to see this final step.” says Phil Bloomfield, SPRA President.
